We are continuing our infectious disease protocols to minimize spread of infections inside of our facilities. We continue to wipe down the rooms in between patients and deep cleaning upon highly contagious cases. We have HEPA filters that purify and clean the air in the room multiple times during a normal visit of the patient and in between patients. Our filters also contain ultraviolet treatment of the air. We continue to leave shielding in place and wear masks to protect ourselves and others when appropriate.
